DO

- Use simple slides that are easy to follow.
- Talk about the subject in such a way that it is clear that you understand it.
- Establish eye contact with each area of the audience.
- Speak clearly with appropriate volume.
- Cover each of the areas from the paper.
- Use images in you slides that are helpful.
- Give credit for images that require attribution.
- Ask questions of the audience.
- Keep the presentation within 12 – 18 minutes.
- Present with enthusiasm.
- Be fully prepared for your presentation.

DO NOT

- Use slides that have too much text or are too busy.
- Read your presentation verbatim off of the slides or off of notes or text.
- Stay behind the podium the entire time.
- Speak too softly or too loudly.
- Use nervous words such as “uhm,” “you know,” “like,” etc. frequently.
- Use images that are too distracting.
- Use images that are copyright protected.
- Present for less than 12 minutes or more than 18 minutes.
- Act like you are bored with the topic.
- Be unprepared for your presentation.
